Applications must be submitted by the due date advertised on the Application Form. Applications received after the closing date may not be considered.

Where you are asked to provide references or referees in support of your application, it is your responsibility to contact your referees and ask them to send their references to the Scholarships Office direct. References sent to the Scholarships Office should be clearly marked with your name and the name of the scholarship(s) for which you are applying. Referees should **not** be asked to send their references to you, as they must have the opportunity to be completely frank. Non-receipt of references or incomplete applications may prejudice your eligibility. The Scholarships Office may contact your referees to discuss references and your application(s).

If official documents are requested as part of your scholarship application, please do not send original documents. Send only copies that have been certified by a Justice of the peace, a solicitor, or a staff member in the Lincoln University registry. **Unless specifically requested, please do not send a curriculum vitae.** Lincoln University accepts no responsibility to return any original documents submitted.

Information submitted with your application must be true and correct.

A breach of Lincoln University's policies or procedures, including a disciplinary or code of conduct finding against you, may result in a scholarship being rescinded.

## **CHECKLIST for Lincoln University Doctoral Scholarship application**

**Closing date: 1<sup>st</sup> October**

It is very important that you correctly fill out all relevant sections in this application form and include all the relevant documents listed below.

Applicants with unanswered questions or incomplete documentation will not be considered for a scholarship.

Applicants that have not been granted admission to Lincoln will not be considered for a scholarship.

Your application form must include:

1. A completed application form.
2. A statement of your research topic, this should be approximately half to one page in length.
3. A current Curriculum vitae.
4. Two academic references as per the application form.
5. A copy of your Lincoln admission letter.
6. Photocopies of all tertiary qualifications, the grading system and graduation certificates for each qualification gained other than those studied at Lincoln University.

The scholarships committee will meet early October and the successful candidates will be informed mid November.
